Holy Week Assemblies!

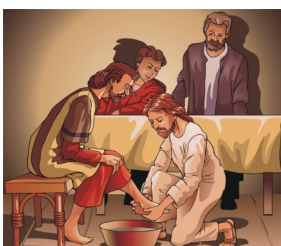

The children were very respectful in their portrayal of these events.

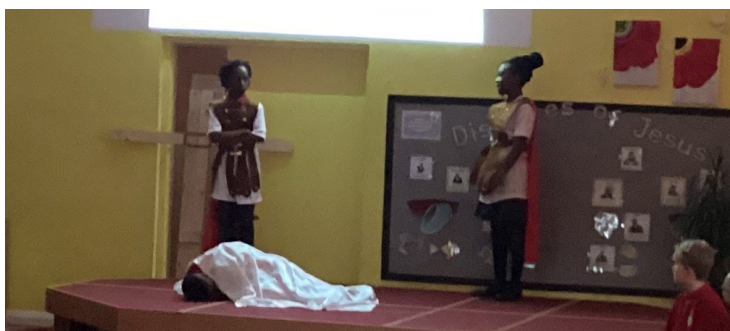
Palm Sunday: Y3
