School Meals

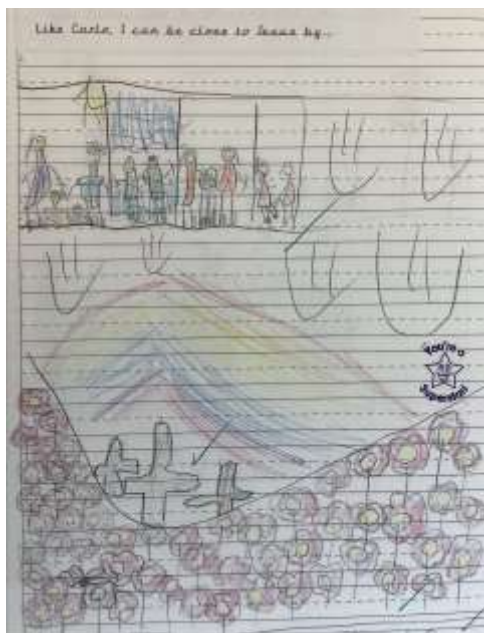
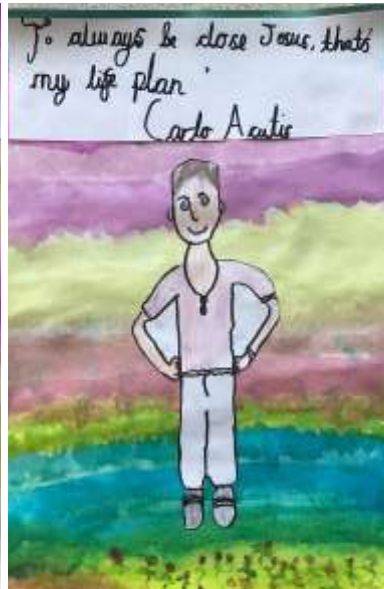
Our school meal provider Edsential have advised us that due to increasing costs, the cost of a school lunch, has increased to £3.20. This change will be effective from Monday 8th September.
