### Ten Pin Bowling

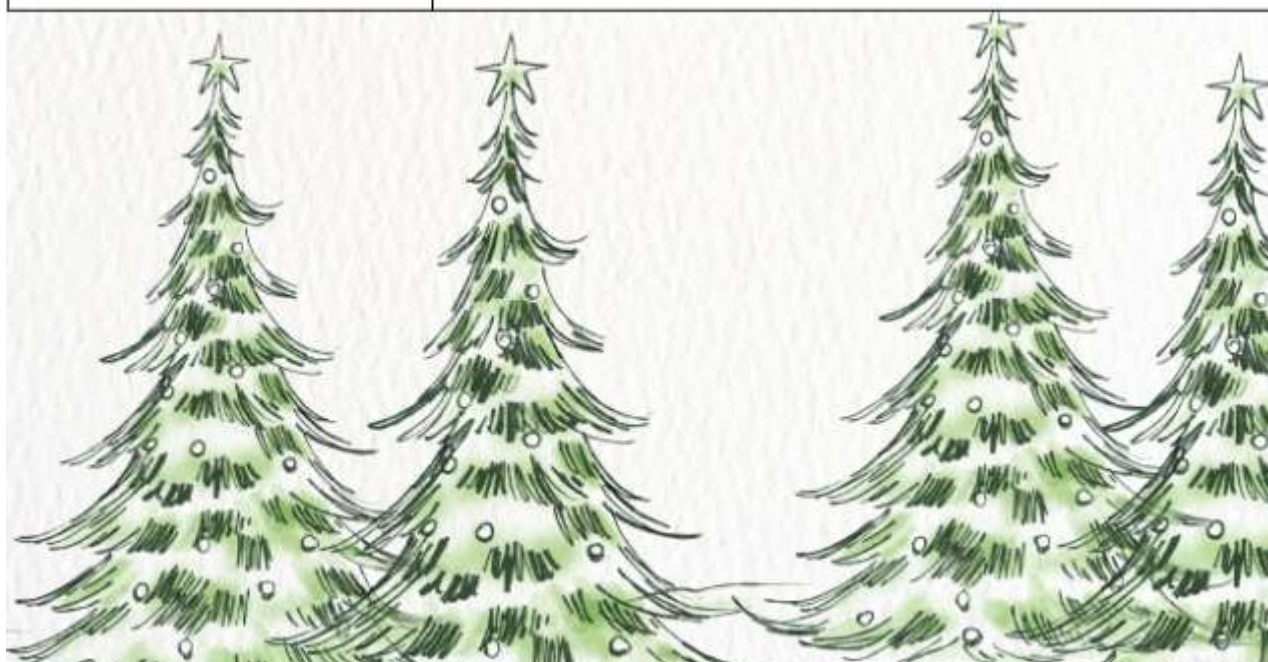
