60 years of St Saviour's!

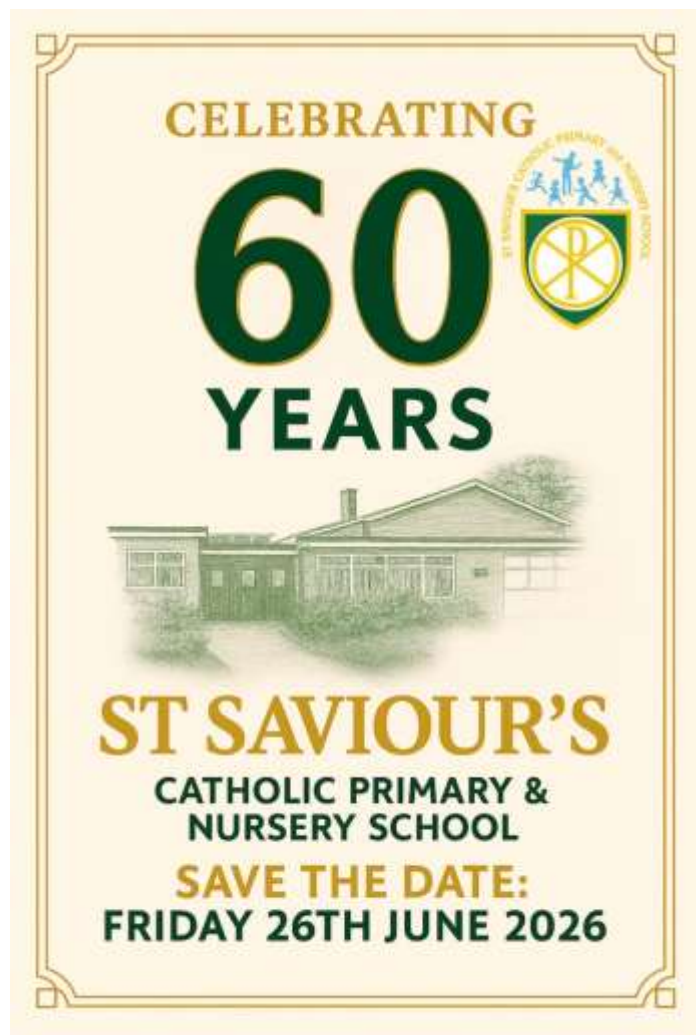
We are looking forward to celebrating 60 years of St Saviour's School this year.
