Fleeces	£8.00

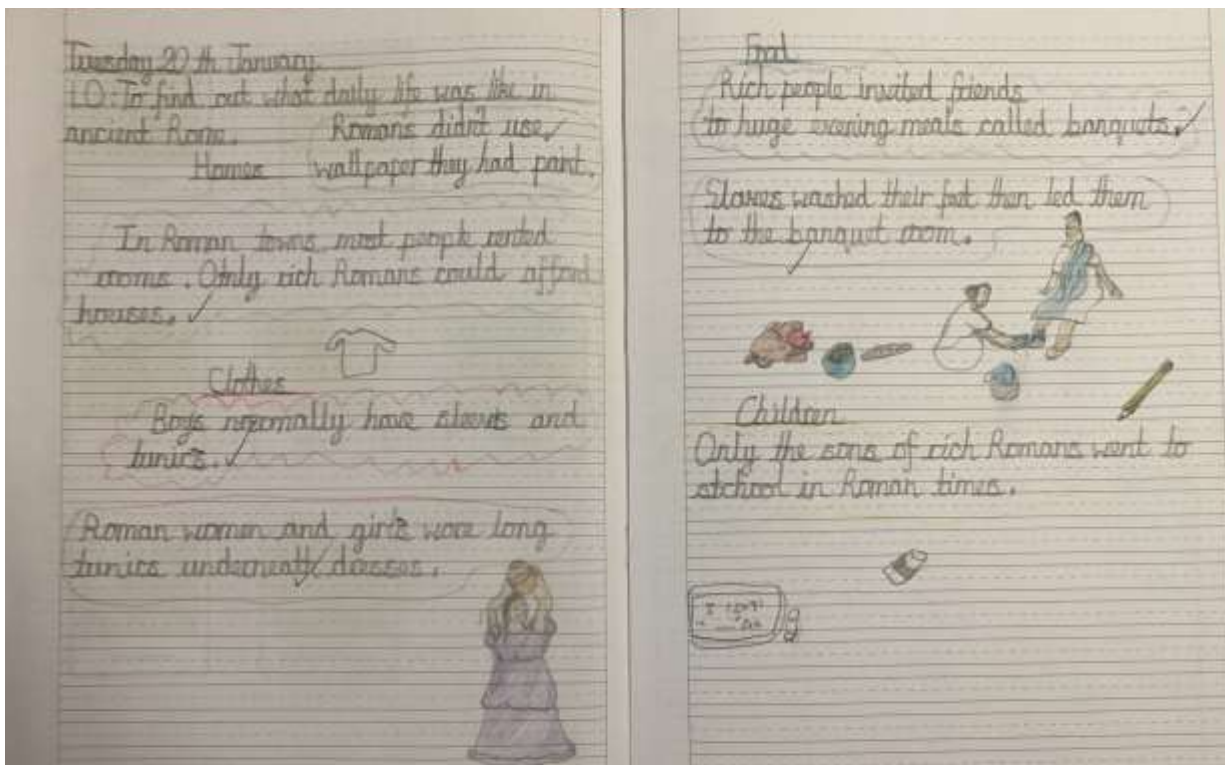
They will continue to sell the red uniform until the end of April 2026 after which time we will supply the green uniform only to ALL year groups.

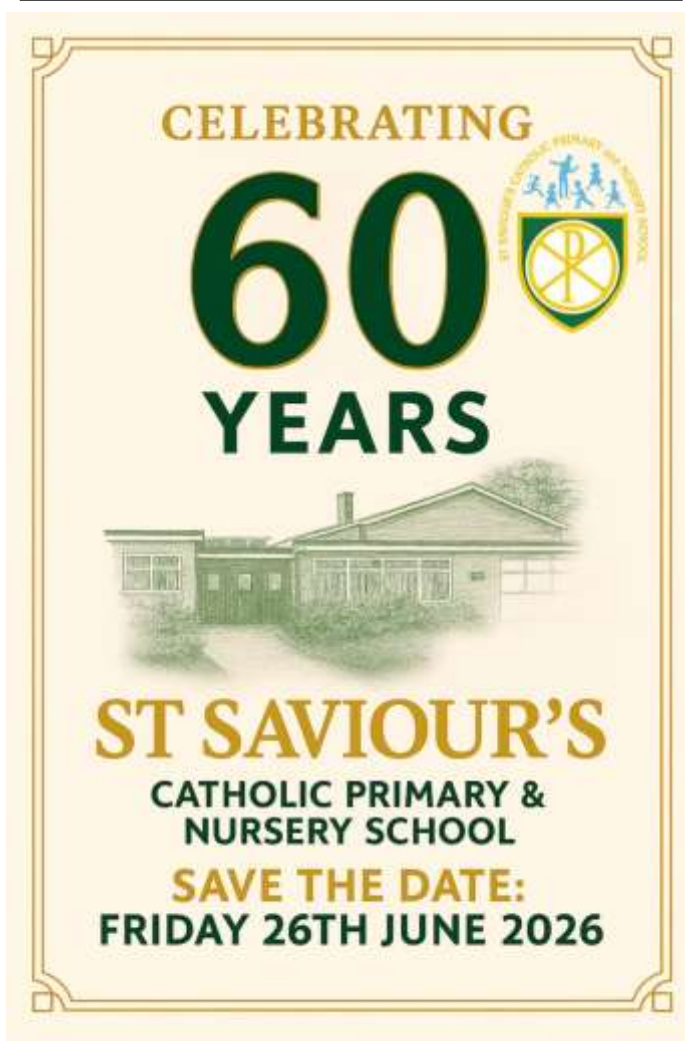


Baking club enjoyed making fairy cakes this week. It was hard work beating the sugar and butter together and cracking the egg so that it went inside the bowl!
