Stations of the Cross at Our Lady's

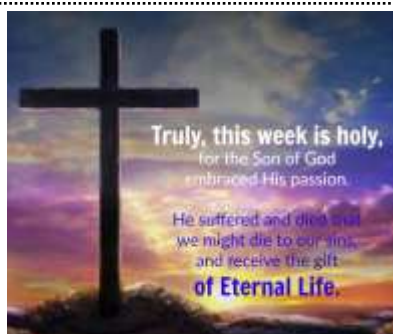
The children in Y4,5,6 led a beautiful Stations
