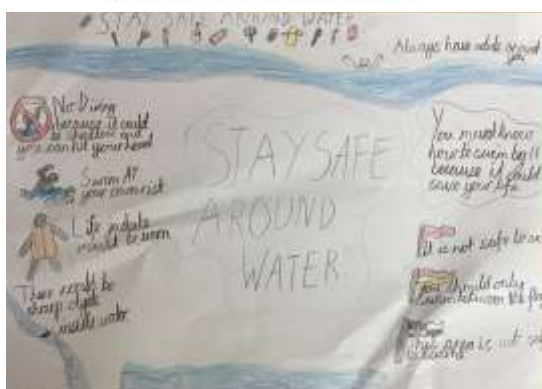
The Y6 Stay and Pray session is next Tuesday at 9am; parents are welcome to attend this.

This week has not only been about fun, but about encouraging lifelong habits. We hope it has inspired everyone to:

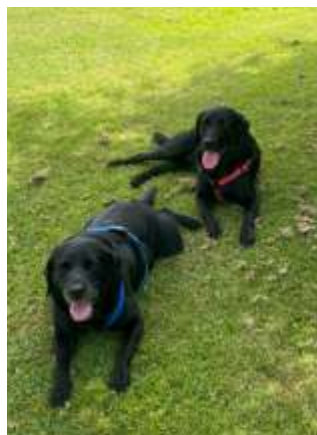
- Stay **active and healthy**

Science and Nature Clubs

Science club and nature club teamed up to explore the pond habitat this week. We used classification posters to help us to identify insects found in and around the pond. We looked at the plants in the habitat and thought about how the insects might use these for survival! It was very exciting to see creatures that we had never seen before!



Geography Club

This week in Geography club we: In Geography Club, we used LEGO to create 3D villages, exploring how places look from a bird's-eye view and considering the resources communities need. The children applied key geography skills, carefully explaining the reasoning behind their designs and the choices they made.

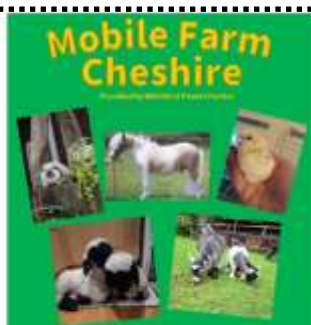
Year 2 Maths

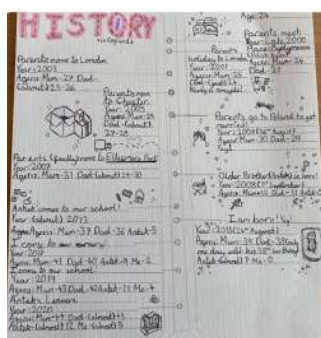
Talent Show
