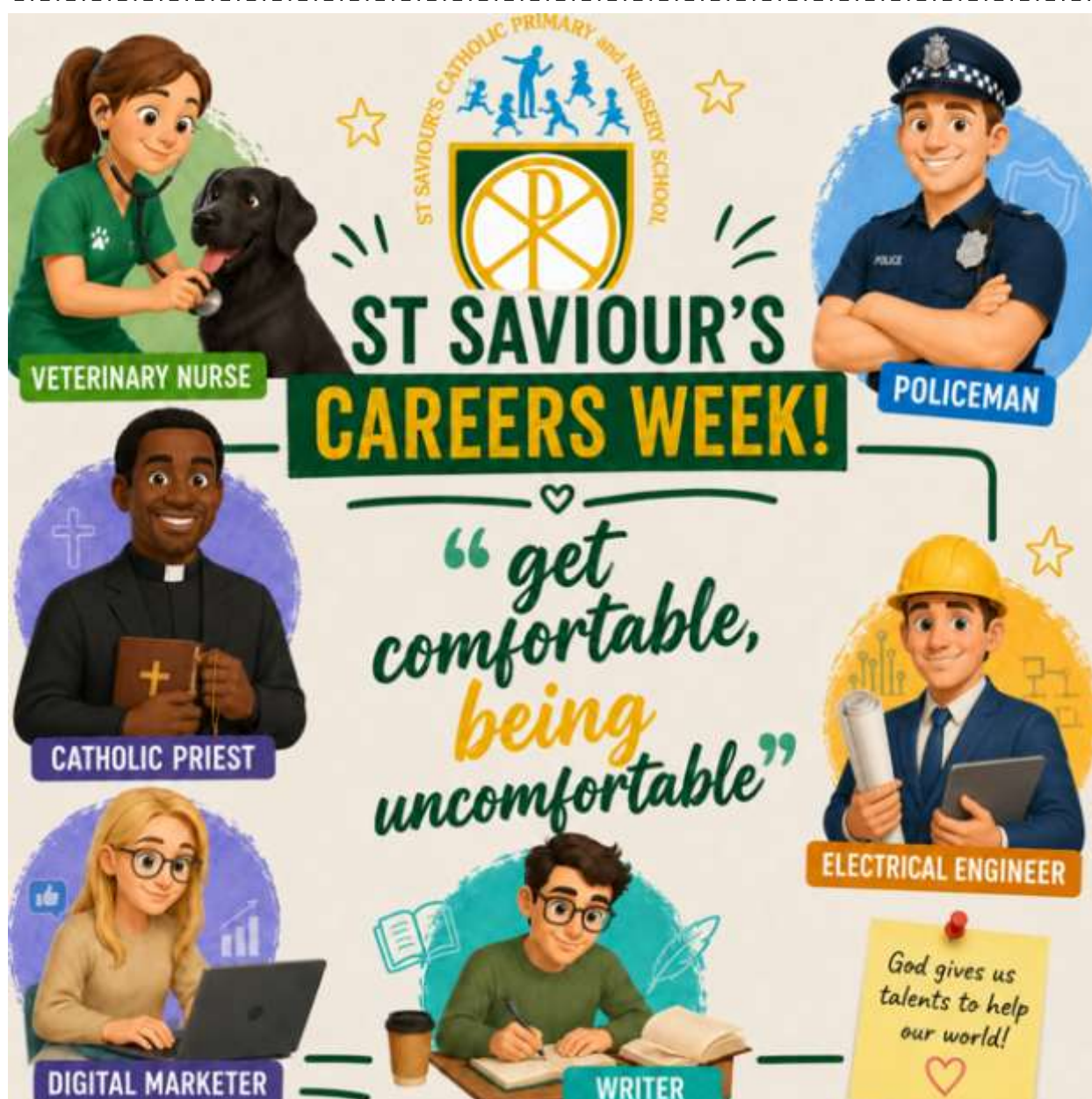


Careers Week

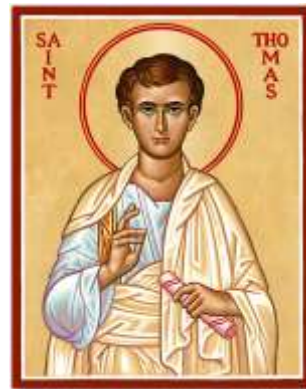
