Pola- *'It's hard to pick something because I loved it all, Coach Danny was AMAZING!'*

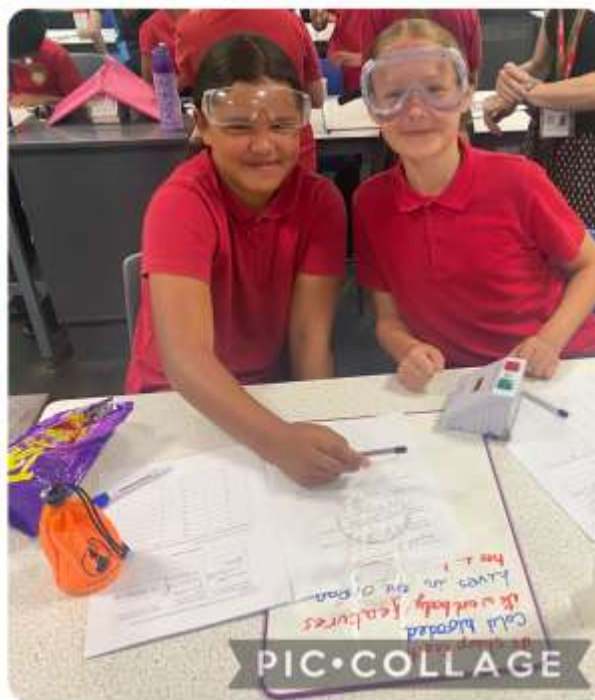
Clark- *'I enjoyed singing with people I wouldn't normally sing with, it's taken me out of my comfort zone and now I can do more!'*
