You are such a fun priest. Never before have we met a priest who shares our love for sport; you race us (and win!); you play football with us and you can do the splits!

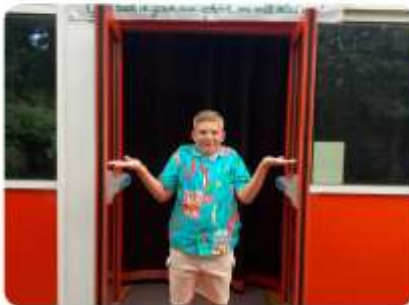


Year 6 Leaver's Mass

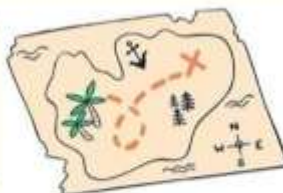
