*'We made the Earth. We learned that we shouldn't throw rubbish in the water because the animals could get hurt.'* Isabelle in Y1

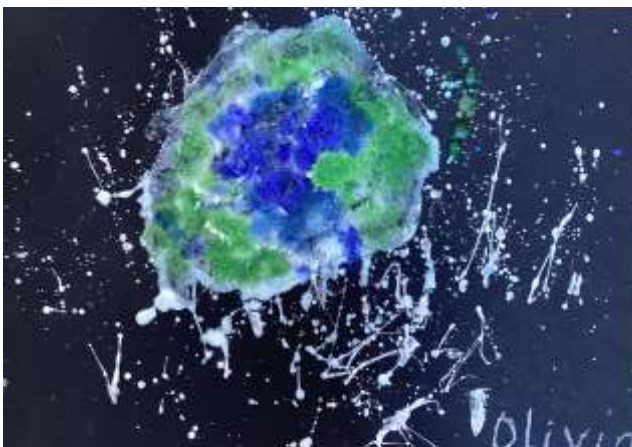
*'We made posters to tell people to not throw trash in the sea because sea creatures can get stuck if we do this.'* Jesse in Y2

# Earth Day!



During Earth day, **Year 1** discussed the process of recycling and why it is important to recycle in order to look after our world. We created world collages and weavings to share this message.



**Year 4** have been learning about the tropical rainforest biome and how we need to protect it. Children thought about how climate change is causing droughts, fires and floods and this can damage habitats and kill animals. They thought about why deforestation is happening and what we can do to help prevent this. Children created paintings to show a healthy rainforest compared to a rainforest facing deforestation and the challenges of climate change.
