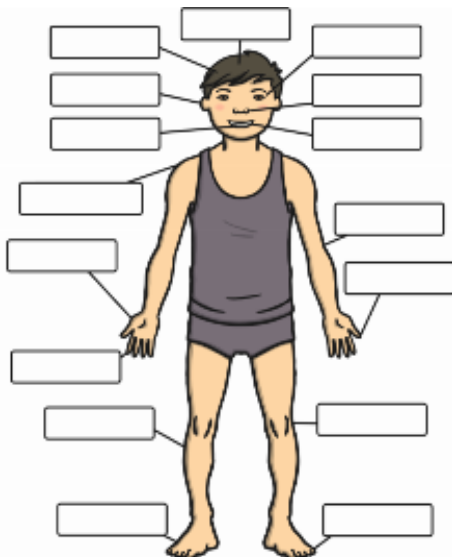

Vocabulary

Animals: Animals are living things.

Amphibian: Amphibians live on land and in water. They lay their eggs in water.

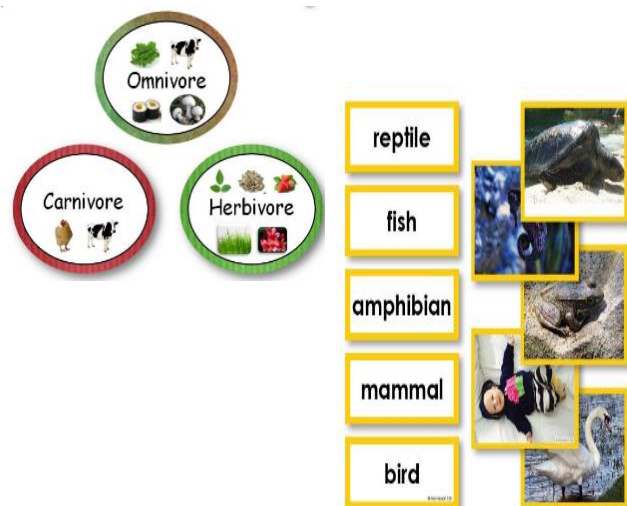
Body: The main part of a person.

Birds: Birds have a beak, wings, feathers and 2 legs. They lay eggs.

Fish: Fish live in water. They have fins instead of legs and gills instead of lungs.

Mammal: Mammals usually have hair or fur. The mothers feed their babies milk.

Reptile: Reptiles live in water and on land. They have scales.
