What should I already know?

- A seed can be used to grow a plant.
- Leaves are one of the parts to a plant.
- The names of some of the months associated to their seasons.

What am I going to learn?

- Leaves, seeds, stems, roots and petals are part of a plant.
- Soil, seeds, water and sunlight are used to plant and grow a bean.
- The fruit of a bean plant is beans.
- Dandelions and daisies are wild plants.
- Roses and sunflowers are garden plants.
- In autumn, the leaves on deciduous trees usually change colour to red and brown and fall off.



Vocabulary

Bean: A seed used to grow a plant.

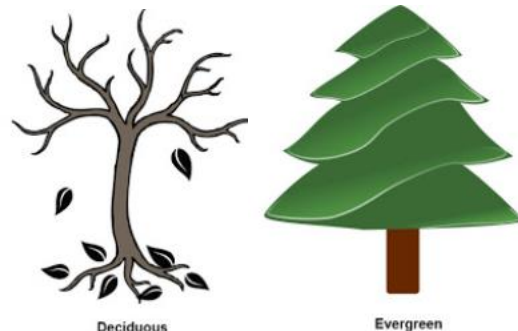
Bulb: Some plants grow first from a seed, and then develop a bulb that helps them to grow back year after year.

Deciduous: A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.

Evergreen: An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round.

Petals: A petal is a coloured part of a flower. They have bright colours and a nice smell.

Roots: A root is a part of a plant that is usually hidden underground. They hold the plant in the ground and keep it upright.
