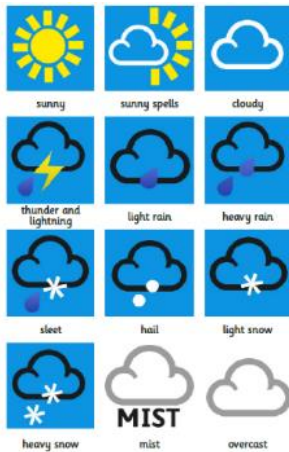
Strand: Physics

What should I already know?

Vocabulary

Bluebells: A plant with blue bell-shaped petals.

Daffodil: A plant with bright yellow petals with a long centre.

Degrees: It is a measurement used to measure temperature.

Seasons: There are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.

Spring: The season after winter and before summer.

Summer: It is the hottest season with lots of heat and sunshine from the sun.

Weather: Weather is the way the air feels.
