Map- a picture showing where things are located in an area.

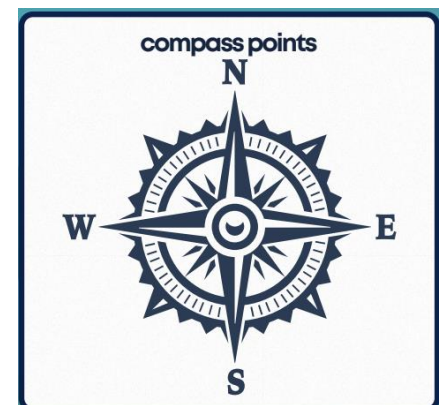
Compass- a tool used to find out directions.
