- A monarch is a King or a Queen, an emperor or an empress.
- Queen Elizabeth I was part of the Tudor family.
- Queen Victoria was the first monarch to move into the famous Buckingham Palace.
- Queen Victoria reigned for 63 years.
- During Queen Victoria's reign, Britain became a rich country; water and electricity were given to towns and all children could go to school.
- Queen Elizabeth II reigned for 70 years (the longest of any monarch).
- A family tree shows the relationship between people in many generations of a family.
- A medieval banquet was a meal and took place for special occasions.



Vocabulary

Royal: A king or queen or a member of their family.

King: A male ruler of a country.

Queen: A woman who rules a country.

Monarch: A King or Queen, an emperor or an empress who rules a country.

Coronation: When a King or Queen is crowned and begins their reign.

Empire: A group of countries ruled over by one monarch.

Government: The people who are in charge of running the country.

Prime Minister: The head of the government.

Buckingham Palace: Where the monarch of the United Kingdom lives when they are in London.
