- Mary Seacole was a nurse who wanted to help injured soldiers in 1853.
- Winston Churchill was a British Prime Minister from 1940-1945 and again in 1951-1955.
- Winston Churchill led Britain to victory in the second world war.
- Lord Shaftsbury helped improve working conditions for poor children.
- Elizabeth Fry first visited a prison in 1813 and found the women and children imprisoned in appalling conditions.
- Elizabeth Fry campaigned for better conditions in prisons.
- William Wilberforce campaigned to abolish the slave trade.
- Emmeline Pankhurst helped women to win the right to vote.
- In 1903 the Women's Social and Political Union was formed by Emmeline Pankhurst.

Achievement: An achievement is something challenging that a person does well.

Significant: Important and worth knowing about.

Impact: Making a big change.

Influential: A thing or person that has the power to affect another.

Parliament: People who work on behalf of others to make laws and debate issues.

Prime Minister: The head of a government in a parliament.

Law: A rule made by a government.

Campaign: A series of planned actions carried out in order to reach a particular goal.

Conditions: the state of something with regard to its appearance or working order.

Allies: To join or unite for a particular purpose.

Abolition: The act of putting an end to something.

Slave Trade: Buying and selling human beings as slaves.

Imprisoned: To be kept in prison.

Inequality: Not being equal.

Protest: Being against something or having an objection over something.

Suffragette: Woman who strongly advocated the right of women to vote.
