*Year 4 will have a 2-week block of swimming lessons during the Autumn term.*

<b>Autumn 1</b> <i>Invasion: Football</i>		<b>Autumn 2</b> <i>Swimming</i>	
Lesson 1	To refine dribbling in order to keep control and possession of the ball.	Lesson 1	
Lesson 2	To explore the purpose of turning in a game of football and understand why turns can help us keep possession.	Lesson 2	
Lesson 3	To see how effectively pupils can apply their passing and moving skills to keep possession, developing this concept into mini game situations.	Lesson 3	
Lesson 4	To develop passing and dribbling to create space, building up into mini games where pupils explore the transition between attack and defence.	Lesson 4	
Lesson 5	To introduce pupils to shooting so that they can understand not just how they shoot but where they shoot from on the pitch, in order to increase their chances of scoring.	Lesson 5	
Lesson 6	To bring together the suggested sequence of learning into a level 1 tournament.	Lesson 6

Lesson 1	To understand why they need to work as a team to create simple tactics.	Lesson 1	To create movements that are creative and include character expression.
Lesson 2	To develop the qualities required to lead a team effectively.	Lesson 2	To create sequences in small groups whilst performing in character.
Lesson 3	To understand what makes an effective team with the focus on collaboration and communication.	Lesson 3	To develop our sequences to show clear character emotion.
Lesson 4	To understand how to solve problems and be successful by collaborating and communicating clearly within their team.	Lesson 4	To create extended sequences with more complex interacting movements and actions.
Lesson 5	To focus on collaboration and communication, enabling them to create simple tactics.	Lesson 5	To create complex sequences with movements that interconnect.
Lesson 6	To focus on collaboration and communication, enabling them to create simple attacking and defending tactics.	Lesson 6	To create a performance that shows how people celebrated the end of World War II.
