## Phonics

Accents	j-	ll-
Accents (á, é, í, ó, ú) indicate the vowel is stressed.	This letter sounds like the sound /h/ in the English word 'hat'.	This letter sounds like the sound /y/ in the English word 'year'.
This is seen in the word <b>pá</b> -ja-ro.	For example, the word <b>oveja</b> sounds /oveha/.	For example, the word <b>caballo</b> sounds /cabayo/.
